**A historic milestone has been reached:
The INTERNATIONAL ANTI-IMPERIALIST LEAGUE
has been founded!**

On April 3rd, 4th, and 5th, the First Founding Congress of the International Anti-Imperialist League (AIL) was successfully held in Cauca, Colombia, a region with a history of peasant, popular, and anti-imperialist resistance. This congress gave birth to the AIL with the drafting and approval of its founding documents: program, statutes, and resolutions of the First Congress. This organization is a tool for the struggle of the peoples, oppressed masses, and nations of the world to develop and wage new battles toward a single goal: to wipe imperialism off the face of the earth once and for all.

After years of hard work and constant struggle to achieve unity, the founding of the AIL is a victory for the exploited and oppressed of the world, achieved right under the nose of U.S. imperialism. The International Anti-Imperialist League takes on the task of uniting as many active forces as possible that fight against imperialism under the revolutionary banner of fighting and resisting without kneeling before the invader.

On the one hand, we see imperialism in a deep and acute crisis, with wars on the rise, a tendency to fascism, and a constant desperation to maintain exploitation and oppression; on the other hand, the peoples of the world are inflamed, enraged, and rising up seeking their liberation. This situation has placed on the agenda the essential task of bringing together all those willing to fight against imperialism and uniting the spontaneous anti-imperialist movement with the conscious revolutionary movement.

Consequently, the slogan that is now on the agenda and that we must raise is “Countries want sovereignty, nations want independence, and peoples want revolution.”

New times have arrived; the winds are blowing in favor of the peoples; the unity and organization of all those willing to struggle against imperialism is an urgent task. It is our duty to organize all efforts, initiatives, and struggles to act as a single fist and strike a blow against imperialism. Peoples of the world, we have a common enemy and a common goal: to cast this outdated and rotten system into the dustbin of history!

The First Congress of the AIL also pays its deepest tribute to all those revolutionaries and democratic masses who have given their lives in the anti-imperialist struggle and organization. In particular, to the internationalist militant Celedonio Luis Santibáñez, a Mexican revolutionary comrade who died while serving the cause of building the International Anti-Imperialist League. We swear, in the name of our martyrs, the poor masses of the world, the massacred Palestinian women and children, the peasants fighting for land, and the oppressed nations resisting the invader, to take up and strengthen the building of this instrument to drive a vigorous anti-imperialist movement, where the peoples unite their struggles and earn their freedom.

The anti-imperialist struggle must direct social and national liberation struggles in a revolutionary manner against imperialism, its collaborators and lackeys. All social problems and contradictions should be addressed in a manner that targets the imperialist system (monopoly capitalism) as the source of the problem and is directed against reactionary political power. Showing solidarity with those revolutionary struggles is essential; otherwise, one cannot be anti-imperialist.

Long live the International Anti-Imperialist League!

FOUNDING MANIFESTO

The main cause of hunger, deep and widespread poverty, and countless unjust wars of plunder and division that drag humanity into great ruin is the imperialist system (monopoly capitalism) that dominates our world. From this perspective, humanity will either become part of its own and the world's annihilation or throw this rotten system into the dustbin of history. There is no other path or intermediary option.

The Anti-Imperialist League positions itself directly as a part of the class struggle, representing one of the two antagonistic sides of this struggle. Our line includes the representation of the just and legitimate demands of the world's workers and laborers, poor and landless peasants, other working segments, including the petty bourgeoisie and progressive intellectuals, and oppressed peoples and nations. This line goes beyond mere complaints or resistance to the current situation; it aims to eradicate the root of oppression and exploitation in this ruthless system. The goal is to transform resistance against injustices into an organized force, unite different segments and classes, and mobilize them for revolution.

While the owners of the exploitative system ruthlessly compete with each other to obtain a greater share of exploitation and expand the scope of exploitation, they also form international alliances against the working class and oppressed peoples of the world.

While the ruling classes try to secure both the imperialist exploitation system and their own spheres of dominance through economic, political, and military organizations at the national and international levels, they deny the right of revolt to oppressed peoples and classes. They try every possible mean to block, divide, or suppress these struggles, because the unity, common struggle, and organization of the oppressed and exploited are their greatest fear. The AIL recognizes the urgent necessity to merge the spontaneous struggle of the masses with the conscious force through action.

While the owners of the exploitative system ruthlessly compete with each other to obtain a greater share of exploitation and expand the scope of exploitation, they also form international alliances against the working class and oppressed peoples of the world. While the ruling classes try to secure both the imperialist exploitation system and their own spheres of dominance through economic, political, and military organizations at the national and international levels, they deny the right of revolt to oppressed peoples and classes. They try every possible way to block, divide, or suppress these struggles, because the unity, common struggle, and organization of the oppressed and exploited are their greatest fear. To ensure the unity of different segments, classes, and peoples that constitute the anti-imperialist struggle and to direct all movements toward the destruction of the imperialist system, it is crucial to fight opportunism within the class struggle and the liberation struggle of the oppressed nations. Opportunism, revisionism, and reformism attempt to divert the direction of anti-imperialist struggles, to place them at the service of imperialism and reaction, to follow a conciliatory line and practice, to divide them, and to lead them into the dead end of reformism or subjugate it to one or another imperialist power.

In the worldwide struggle to overthrow imperialism the principal force is the vast poor peasant masses, which compose the majority of the exploited and oppressed of the world. The peasants fight for land against the landlords, the main ally of imperialism in oppressed nations, and hence the development of the agrarian revolution in the oppressed nations will deal decisive blows to the imperialist world system. Therefore, the AIL struggles to build a firm working-peasant alliance and considers this unity the fundamental basis to construct a powerful anti-imperialist front.

The anti-imperialist political line of the Anti-Imperialist League is characterized by trust in the organized power of the oppressed peoples and masses and revolutionary violence as a decisive form of struggle. It supports the national liberation wars, revolutionary wars and People's Wars.

Under the current conditions, in which imperialism forces billions of people to live under conditions of slavery, in which the people are put under the harshest oppression and which promote bloody wars of occupation, aggression, and plunder, it is our inevitable responsibility to establish the unity of the anti-imperialist movement and advance the class struggle against imperialism and reaction.

The International Anti-Imperialist League (AIL) is the practical organization of this responsibility

INTERNATIONAL ANTI-IMPERIALIST LEAGUE: PROGRAM

The nature of the International Anti-Imperialist League

a) The International Anti-Imperialist League is an anti-imperialist (and therefore combats the capitalist system), anti-colonial, anti-fascist and anti-feudal formation. We oppose imperialism, its lackeys and all forms of reaction; we argue that all of these are doomed to defeat as “paper tigers.”

b) The International Anti-Imperialist League considers the imperialist system as the source of all the problems we face. Therefore, its struggle is not only against the apparent negative consequences but also aims to eliminate the causes of these consequences.

c) The International Anti-Imperialist League is based on the principle of democratic centralism, adopts the policy of “from the masses to the masses” and adopts the mechanism of criticism and self-criticism as a method of responsibility toward the masses, as required by this policy.

OBJECTIVES OF THE INTERNATIONAL ANTI-IMPERIALIST LEAGUE

1) The International Anti-Imperialist League struggles for the broadest unity of workers, peoples and oppressed nations against imperialism. To achieve this task, it commits itself to struggle for unity according to the revolutionary necessity. The oppressed masses and nations of the world will sweep this “giant on clay feet” from the face of the earth. Our slogan for struggle is: “Anti-imperialists of the world, unite!”

2) The International Anti-Imperialist League supports and is part of the struggle of the world proletariat, the peasants and other masses of the peoples and oppressed nations against the ideological, political, economic, military and cultural attacks carried out by imperialism and the oppressive and exploitative ruling classes, which form a part of its reactionary chains. The AIL supports the nation’s struggle for independence and their right for self-determination and works towards defending every nation’s sovereignty and territorial integrity.

Defending the struggles for the daily demands of the people

3) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends and attaches great importance to the economic struggles and struggles for the daily demands of the working class and the peoples. It calls for the development of struggles for the daily demands of the masses in service of the revolution. The AIL defends the people’s rights and emphasizes that the most fundamental of these is the right to seize and exercise political power.

4) The International Anti-Imperialist League shares the concerns of the proletariat and the people about the future of their children and defends the rights of children. Today, millions of children around the world are working under the harshest conditions. The countries with the highest level of child labor are particularly in Asia, Latin America and Africa.

Child labor is heavily used in the plundering of raw materials and natural resources in oppressed countries where imperialist monopolies have reaped immense profits by exploiting child labor. Likewise, this labor is widely used in the large subcontracted production companies in these countries.

The Anti-Imperialist League supports the struggle against the exploitation of child labor and considers it to be one of its important tasks.

5) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends the right for universal and public education and supports the struggle to remove barriers to access to education for the oppressed and poor children and youth. The AIL promotes education to be provided within the framework of scientific principles and in service to the people. We support education being free at all levels and defend academic freedom; we support university autonomy and firmly reject the anti-people policies that aim to privatize and dismantle public education.

6) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends the right to universal and public healthcare and rejects the privatization of health systems worldwide, as this makes it impossible for the oppressed to access health care. It regards social security and its free character as an essential right for workers in the cities and the countryside. We denounce that millions of people are dying or being infected by epidemics created by imperialism.

The AIL fights against all crimes committed by pharmaceutical monopolies, rejects monopolistic patent registration and supports the efforts of the forces that struggle so that all workers and oppressed classes have unconditional and free access to this fundamental right.

7) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends the right to decent housing for workers and the masses of the people and fights against overcrowding, unhealthy living conditions, forced evictions and dispossession policies imposed by reactionary governments and real estate mafias. Today, billions of people are deprived of the right to decent housing; hundreds of millions struggle to survive in slums, on the streets, and in unhealthy conditions, with most lacking basic public services especially access to drinking water. The AIL supports all forms of struggle that people use to obtain this right.

DEFENDING DEMOCRATIC FREEDOMS AND POLITICAL RIGHTS

8) The International Anti-Imperialist League stands against all forms of obscurantism and takes a position in defense of the freedom of religion, to believe or not believe, as part of the struggle for democracy.

9) The International Anti-Imperialist League supports all organizational and resistance efforts for the emancipation of women workers, laboring women, poor peasant women and women from indigenous communities. In addition to class exploitation, women are also oppressed due to their sex and live under patriarchal violence. This violence includes the sexual oppression and exploitation of women, as well as that of children. The AIL is convinced that the true liberation of women is only possible through the liberation of all oppressed classes and argues that all efforts should serve this goal.

10) The International Anti-Imperialist League regards the youth of the people as an important part of the anti-imperialist struggle and ensures that young people play an active role in this struggle. Shaped by a revolutionary and progressive consciousness, the youth of the people play an indispensable role in the class struggle of the proletariat and the oppressed. However, the youth are attacked by reactionary ideologies and cultural currents that promote individualism and alienation, aiming to dull their revolutionary spirit. It is the AIL's essential duty to stand against all reactionary ideological and cultural aggression that tries to pacify the youth and make them part of the exploitative system, and to shape the youth with the progressive values of the people.

11) The International Anti-Imperialist League denounces that imperialism is not only the enemy of progressive culture but also of the historical development of humanity's culture and considers changing this situation one of its main duties. The progressive culture of the peoples is the expression of values created by humanity from past to present, and this continuity is important for building the future of peoples.

In the imperialist world system dominated by monopoly capitalism, the development of national democratic culture is not possible, because imperialism imposes its hegemonic culture based on individualism and wicked reactionary ideology (fascism, pseudo-liberalism, postmodernism or others) on the lives of the people, academia and art. Imperialism means alienation from the values of one's own society, cultural decline and cultural repression. The AIL struggles for the free development of the democratic cultures of all peoples and nations and especially supports all efforts to foster progressive national culture in oppressed countries.

12) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends the right to migrate as one of humanity's fundamental rights and accuses imperialism and its violence for the poverty created by the exploitative system in which we live. Imperialism is responsible for that, as well as for unjust and reactionary wars, as well as the plunder, the destruction of living spaces and other reasons that force the phenomenon of mass migration. People have to go to other countries and regions in order to reach more secure and livable conditions. The states of the imperialist countries promote migration from oppressed countries and nations to increase the exploitation of cheap labor and at the same time establish reactionary migratory politics, with the intention to massacre and exploit the working migrant masses.

The reactionary states promote politics that want to divide and confront the working class based on nationality. The AIL struggles to protect migrant workers facing discrimination, racism, persecution, arrest and other crimes of which they are victims. We emphasize that workers have no homeland so we have to struggle for the full access to equal rights as citizens in the destination countries. The Anti-imperialist League recognizes fleeing from imperialist devastation as a right, but at the same time struggles against the causes and consequences of migration, that imperialism has created.

13) The International Anti-Imperialist League firmly opposes all forms of oppression and persecution that individuals face due to their sexual orientation. Recognizing this stance as a fundamental part of the broader struggle for democracy, the League considers defending the rights of people regardless of their sexual orientation as an essential element in building a fair and democratic society. The League's commitment includes opposing any discriminatory practices or policies that undermine or exclude individuals based on their sexual orientation.

Defending the rights of workers and the people

14) The International Anti-Imperialist League supports the economic struggles of the proletariat and the toiling masses. It opposes all policies that strengthen the exploitation of the working masses and seek to divide or weaken them against capital and its lackeys.

This also includes the struggle to establish class unionism within unions that compromise with the bourgeoisie and make agreements with it. The AIL emphasizes that the struggle of the working class is not limited to the interests and methods of unions alone, and states that the class must seize political leadership within unions.

For this purpose, revolutionary activity must be carried out even within the most reactionary unions; in this mission, workers will find our unwavering support. The AIL also supports all class unions where the economic and democratic rights of the working class are expressed and fought for. We aim to achieve the unity and solidarity of class unions at both national and international levels.

15) The International Anti-Imperialist League defends the rights of poor and landless peasants, rural laborers, and oppressed indigenous peoples against feudal, semi-feudal, and capitalist-imperialist exploitation. AIL upholds the slogan “Land to those who live and work on it!” and supports all struggles aimed at the revolutionary abolition of the property of the big landowners. AIL supports the struggle against the burden of debt imposed on peasants and denounces that imperialism, in order to make maximum profits, maintains feudal or semi-feudal relations in order to benefit from the free labor of the peasantry and working masses, principally in the oppressed nations.

16) The International Anti-Imperialist League supports the struggle against the seizure of communal lands belonging to indigenous peoples and the destruction of their living spaces by international agricultural and industrial monopolies and major landowners. The expropriation of indigenous lands by international monopolies and large landowners is not merely the shameless theft of property. It also represents the severing of indigenous peoples from their own traditions and cultures, as well as the loss of the continuity of their historical consciousness.

The current situation of imperialist oppression of indigenous people is directly connected in direct form with the processes of colonization and occupation by the North American and European invaders of vast regions that extended from the Americas to Asia and from Africa to Oceania, with this, they attacked the historical memory of the native villages, causing the significant destruction of their cultural and social values.

The AIL greets all the indigenous peoples and native peoples and that today resist for their lands, traditions and their existence.

The struggle supported by the Anti-Imperialist League is not only a defense of economic rights, but also a fight to preserve the cultural identity and maintain the historical memory of indigenous peoples. The International Anti-Imperialist League embraces the struggle of indigenous peoples against such policies of seizure and destruction, and resolutely supports the protection of their lands, traditions, and cultural continuity.

17) The International Anti-Imperialist League rejects those energy, tourist, industrial and transport projects, that harm the interests of the people and which are imposed upon oppressed countries for imperialist interests. It states that these projects lead to exploitation and loss of living spaces for rural poor and indigenous peoples, with natural resources being used to benefit international monopolies and their local collaborators. The AIL argues that these processes destroy the livelihoods of rural populations, exclude local communities from decision-making, damage historical heritage, and serve the interests of short-term profit, thereby deepening social injustices. The AIL maintains that it is necessary to nationalize the mineral and natural resources as a way to combat the appropriation of them by the big imperialists companies.

It draws attention to the negative impacts that these mega projects have on the social, economic, and cultural fabric of colonial and semi-colonial countries. Monopolist mining leads to the depletion of soil fertility, contamination of water resources, and loss of biodiversity; energy and industrial mega projects result in environmental pollution and the seizure of people's land, while voracious tourism investments reveal the destruction of traditional ways of life. All this destroys the foundation for the livelihoods of the peasantry often leading to their displacement.

Similarly, it opposes the creation of corridors of exploitation and death through tourism projects and industrial investments. It fights against and supports struggles against new and "modern" railway, highway, seaway and airway transport projects, designed under the bureaucratic development model in oppressed countries and serving to facilitate counter-insurgent operations and the military transport of occupying forces.

AIL takes a determined stand against all these mega projects and supports the resistance of the peoples in oppressed countries. To this end, it encourages collective actions and builds solidarity networks by working in cooperation with environmental movements, trade unions, and indigenous organizations in various countries, developing joint strategies to prevent these harms and fighting for a globally just and sustainable future. It stands against all imperialist mega projects that harm the interests of the people and intensify the exploitation and oppression of the rural poor and are met with the justified resistance of the masses, especially in oppressed countries.

18) The International Anti-Imperialist League fights against plunder that commodifies the entire planet and its underground resources, land, sea, and air. The natural habitats of all living beings are being destroyed in the name of maximizing profit. In this process, the privatization of water and its exploitation is only for the benefit of imperialist monopolies and their lackeys. AIL opposes the mercantilization of water and its detachment from society; it resolutely defends the struggle for access to clean water, one of humanity's most basic needs. To resist the destruction of nature and living spaces is not only an environmental but also a social responsibility.

Nature must be protected and used scientifically and rationally for the benefit of all peoples and all living beings. With this understanding, the Anti-Imperialist League advocates for the management of natural wealth, land, and water in accordance with social interests and in a manner that will be bequeathed to future generations, and supports struggles conducted in this direction.

Against repression, militarism and war

19) The International Anti-Imperialist League recognizes the legitimacy of social and national independence struggles, revolutionary wars, people's wars, and national liberation wars waged against imperialism and its collaborators and regards these struggles as part of the anti-imperialist movement.

It fights against discrimination, racism, and national oppression implemented by imperialists and their collaborating ruling classes. It defends the right of the oppressed peoples and nations to self-determination and advocates for the full rights of the oppressed nationalities living within imperialist countries.

20) The International Anti-Imperialist League stands with communist, revolutionary, and progressive political prisoners and prisoners of war who fight for social, national, and democratic liberation, and supports them by all means. It struggles for the safe return of those arrested by state forces and subsequently disappeared.

21) The International Anti-Imperialist League stands against the wars of aggression and occupation conducted by imperialists and the forces of exploitative ruling classes to repartition the world and condemns the imperialist system as the source of all wars.

22) The International Anti-Imperialist League maintains that imperialism everywhere and always leads to the reactionary transformation and militarization of society, and carries within itself a tendency towards fascism, which emerges as an alleged “solution” to the imperialist crisis. The AIL supports the struggle against police violence, military repression, and all other forms of state terror imposed on the masses. The AIL rejects the sham of the “war on drugs” used by imperialism to unleash wars of aggression and wage counter-revolutionary wars throughout the world

23) The International Anti-Imperialist League opposes all military and economic alliances (NATO, IMF, World Bank, UN, BRICS, EU, etc.) established by imperialist states and ruling classes and regards the struggle against them as one of the main goals of anti-imperialist resistance. This struggle also encompasses military agreements, migration treaties, and the war industries imposed on oppressed peoples. The AIL stands firmly against militarism and imperialist wars and is completely opposed to reactionary war alliances.

24) The International Anti-Imperialist League struggles against the instruments of violence (army, police, secret services, etc.) used by the dominant system to suppress and control the people and opposes all reactionary forms seeking to subjugate the masses. This is because imperialism is reactionary in every sense. This reactionary system produces economic, political, and social crises. The crisis-inducing structure of the imperialist system inevitably fosters tendencies towards militarism and fascism within the ruling order and among the social sectors it influences.

We call on workers, laborers and peasant organizations, democratic and revolutionary groups, consequent anti-imperialist movements, and progressive and revolutionary intellectuals around the world to unite our forces to build this great stronghold against imperialism, fascism, and unjust wars.

STATUTES OF THE INTERNATIONAL ANTI-IMPERIALIST LEAGUE

1) General Characteristics of the International Anti-Imperialist League

Article 1. Name

The name of the organization is the **International Anti-Imperialist League (AIL)**.

Article 2. Ideological Principles

The ideological, political, and organizational basis of unity for the AIL is the “Program” and the Statutes. Both documents are approved by the Congress and can only be changed, adjusted, or supplemented by the Congress.

Article 3. Symbols

3.1. Official slogan: Anti-imperialists of the world, unite!

3.2. Emblem:



2) Organizational Principles of the International Anti-Imperialist League

Article 4. Democratic Centralism

4.1 The International Anti-Imperialist League is based on the principle of democratic centralism, and this principle is decisive for all its activities.

4.2 In accordance with the principle of democratic centralism, the members of the International Anti-Imperialist League will participate in the decision-making process and in defining the political and practical orientations of the AIL.

4.3 The members of the International Anti-Imperialist League adhere to the decisions made within the framework of democratic centralism and practical work, acting with a sense of responsibility for the success of the adopted political, practical, and organizational work.

Article 5. Membership

5.1 The International Anti-Imperialist League is open to the participation of all organizations and individuals who define themselves as anti-imperialist and accept the Program and Statutes of the AIL. The AIL accepts as members all individuals and organizations that also accept the principle of democratic centralism and the Program of the AIL.

Article 6. Financial Autonomy

6.1 The International Anti-Imperialist League is governed by the principle of self-sustainability, promoting independent and sustainable economic management.

6.2 All officials and leaders of the AIL hold their positions pro bono, without salary, to ensure transparency and militant commitment.

6.3 Each national section is responsible for organizing its economic activities under the principle of self-sustainability, ensuring the financial viability of its actions without relying on external sources that compromise its political independence.

3) Organizational Structure of the International Anti-Imperialist League

Article 7. International Congress

7.1 The supreme body of the International Anti-Imperialist League is the AIL Congress, which will meet every five years or earlier in an extraordinary manner if the political situation demands it. There will be delegates elected by the national sections.

7.2 Responsibilities:

- a) Define the strategic political line.
- b) Elect and remove the Executive Commission.
- c) Amend the Statutes.

Article 8. Executive Committee

8.1 In the period between two Congresses, the International Anti-Imperialist League will be led and guided by an Executive Committee composed of 5 members elected at the Congress.

8.2 Functions:

- a) Implement Congress resolutions.
- b) Promote and plan international campaigns and activities.
- c) Coordinate activities between national sections and the organization as a whole.
- d) Issue statements on behalf of the AIL.

Article 9. Advisory Council

9.1 Regional structures (America, Africa, Asia, Europe) to coordinate local actions.

9.2 Composed of 1 to 2 representatives per national section, elected by national assemblies.

9.3 Every six months, it submits its observations, proposals, and criticisms to the Executive Comision, either in meetings or in writing.

Anti-Imperialists of the world, unite!

Defend the peoples in struggle in India against the genocidal operations of the fascist Modi Brahmanic-Hindutva government!

The International Anti-imperialist League in its Founding Congress calls on all anti-imperialist forces in the world to launch a historical campaign of international solidarity with the Indian People that have resisted and fought against the terrorist and genocidal Operation Kagaar by the Brahmanic Hindutva fascist government of Narendra Modi!

The operation Kagaar is part of an abominable counter-revolutionary campaign of repression, genocide and slaughter of Indian workers and peasants, of the Adivasi population, and its most combative segment, especially of the Maoist revolutionaries. While political executions and selective assassinations in false encounters and torture increase, the masses of peasants and tribal peoples are displaced from their lands, have their possessions confiscated or destroyed by the repressive forces together with paramilitaries at the service of the big mining corporations; women suffer sexual violations and the youth is being persecuted and illegally detained. The most elementary rights of the people are being revoked in India. Since mid-2025 and into early 2026 the increasingly macabre means of genocide have increased the massacre, with the explicit political and material support in technology and armaments from the Zionist entity of Israel and with covert direction of Yankee imperialism and in complicity with the other imperialist powers.

In several parts of India, in addition to repressing poor masses, Adivasis, peasants, and the working class, students, intellectuals, and democrats who are supportive of the people's struggle are also being pursued, abducted, disappeared,

arrested, and tortured, in an attempt to intimidate protests and mobilizations in the cities in the defense of the people's minimum democratic rights.

This Operation has the immediate economic objective of the expulsion of the original peoples from their lands rich in minerals in order to hand them over to the big mineral monopolies of the Indian big bourgeoisie and in service of imperialism - such as Arcelor Mittal, Jindal, Usha Martin, Rungta Mines, Adani, etc- or imperialist finance capital. But the principal political and military objective of these fascists is to defeat the revolution, led by the great Communist Party of India (Maoist) and the heroic People's War in India, to deter the peoples' resistance and widen the militarization and the massacre against the poor of the countryside which have resisted the genocide for decades against the plunder and displacement and united vigorously making the ongoing Agrarian Revolution as first step in order to realize the New Democratic Revolution in the country.

This operation, moreover, is not a strictly military offensive: It is a complex operation that includes treason within the ranks of the revolutionaries, and is an integral part of a sinister plan of Imperialism to destroy revolutionary struggles and the national liberation struggles in the world. So they concentrated their reactionary and terrorist forces, with the decisive contribution of traitors and capitulationist revisionist renegades, to assassinate Comrade Basavaraj, General Secretary of the Communist Party of India (Maoist) on 26th of May, 2025 and hundred of other revolutionary leaders. If they believe that through this they will stop the revolution in India, they are mistaken.

In truth, that aforementioned sinister operation is already defeated: following their example, the people continue to rise in various regions of the country and the world and new generations of combatants will arise.

Comrades and friends of the Indian struggle,

The Founding Congress of the International Anti-imperialist League solemnly declares: Our minds and hearts are united with the unbreakable decision to fight until the end for your liberation and to put into motion a tempestuous force in defense of your revolution. We communicate to you and to all the anti-imperialist forces in the world:

The more than 150 congress representatives of 50 delegations of 14 countries have unanimously decided to create throughout the the world the Committees in Solidarity with the Indian People and to launch a massive campaign that will be a historical milestone demonstrating the impulse and anti-imperialist unity to make everything that is possible in order to keep the wicked hands of the fascists off from the Indian people.

So we call to develop this great campaign in the actions and protest of 1st of May of this year, putting forward the slogan: **“STOP OPERATION KAGAAR! ANTI-IMPERIALISTS OF THE WORLD, UNITE!”**

Death to Brahmanic Hindutva fascism of Narendra Modi!

Greetings to the Palestinian People and to the Palestinian Resistance, Full Support to Palestinian Prisoners of War!

The Anti-Imperialist League, at its Founding Congress, salutes with strong resolve and enthusiasm the Palestinian people, the Palestinian National Resistance, and all combatants of this exemplary national liberation struggle in the history of humanity-for their sacrifice, their courage, and their devotion to the highest values of progressive humanity around the world.

The Palestinian people have for nearly 80 years faced genocide, forced displacement, and the steadily expanding occupation of their lands. Especially since October 7, they have resisted and inflicted heavy blows upon Yankee imperialism, represented by its advanced outpost in the Middle East-the Zionist settler entity-one of the most distinct fascist forms of the 21st century.

Access to medicine, food, and clean water has been systematically obstructed, turned into a weapon used against the people. Schools, mosques, hospitals, aid workers, and the press have been directly targeted; the vast majority of housing has been destroyed, and agricultural lands have been rendered unusable. Bombardments have extended even to the camps where millions of people displaced within the country have taken shelter.

Facing these crimes against humanity and the systematic denial of the most fundamental rights of peoples, the heroic and unshakable National Resistance Front of the Palestinian people launched its audacious counteroffensive on October 7, 2023: Operation Al-Aqsa Flood.

To all those with common sense, it is clear that it is a legitimate right for peoples under occupation to wage an armed struggle for liberation in the face of such brutality. Al-Aqsa Flood is a great victory, especially because it has thwarted the successive plans of Yankee imperialism and its Zionist outpost. At the same time, it demonstrates to the entire world that imperialism is not invincible, that it is a giant with feet of clay that can be brought down.

This operation is both the call and the sign of a new era in the anti-imperialist struggle ; it symbolizes the beginning of a new anti-imperialist wave rising in Europe, the Americas, Africa, and Asia. Furthermore, it has effectively nullified the Abraham Accords and similar arrangements aimed at making the Zionist colonial occupation permanent. Its message is clear : However militarily brutal and powerful the enemy may be, the oppressed peoples can achieve victory and ultimately will.

The Anti-Imperialist League resolves to stand in solidarity with all political organizations supporting the national resistance struggle of the Palestinian people. In particular, it undertakes effective action to defend Palestinian and Lebanese prisoners of war, political prisoners, and abducted persons held in Zionist prisons and now placed under the threat of extrajudicial execution by a newly enacted Israeli law. The AIL defends the rights of all political prisoners of the Palestinian National Resistance and of those arbitrarily detained, and demands their immediate release.

To extend internationalist support to the Palestinian people, to their National Resistance, and to prisoners of war, urgent and concrete action-not words-is now required.

Condemn Yankee Imperialism's Intervention in Venezuela and Latin America!

The Anti-Imperialist League, at its Founding Congress, once again expresses its profound hatred and anger at the military intervention carried out by Yankee imperialism against the sovereign Venezuelan nation, which resulted in the abduction of the country's legitimate president, Nicolás Maduro, and First Lady Cilia Flores. It condemns the bombing of the Caribbean waters of Venezuela and Colombia and the massacre of more than a hundred people from these countries.

The Anti-Imperialist League stands against the military occupation of the Caribbean and the illegal seizure of Venezuelan oil and natural resources. The Anti-Imperialist League declares the necessity of actively struggling so that the Venezuelan people may unite around a position of national resistance. What is therefore decisive is the strengthening of armed mass organizations and the raising of the radicalization of the entire nation's anti-imperialist struggle.

This savage imperialist act is not an isolated incident. It is part of Yankee imperialism's broader intervention on the subcontinent and in this hemisphere. It is part of a strategic plan to deter the rise in anti-imperialist and popular resistance and to prevent the growing presence of its imperialist rivals in its "backyard." To this end, it is now mobilizing its war machine against Cuba, seeking

to destroy the political system that defies the empire's orders, and aiming to double its pressure on a people who have resisted for years the illegitimate political and economic blockade imposed by Yankee imperialism. For this, the Anti-Imperialist League adopts the slogan: Cuba Yes! Yankees No!

The Yankees have sent troops to Paraguay on the Brazilian border; they are conducting military exercises in Panama and imposing control over the Panama Canal. They are issuing military ultimatums to force the Colombian Government to further submit to the new form of the interventionist policy; U.S. imperialism is leading the counter-revolutionary bombardment in Catatumbo, Ituango, and the Colombian Amazon. As part of a strategic plan for Latin America, they have turned El Salvador into a large concentration camp directly under their command; they have deepened the military occupation in Mexico and intensified the war against the people under the pretext of the "war on drugs" — a business which imperialism itself promotes for its own political and economic interests.

What is seen in these countries can be observed throughout all of Latin America and the Caribbean, where Yankee Imperialism, often under the pretext of "combating narco-terrorism," is tightening its yoke on oppressed nations in order to intensify the exploitation of the masses and of natural resources, to block the presence of other imperialist powers in the region, and to deepen the military occupation of the region as part of its preparation for imperialist war and its attempt to prevent revolution.

It is especially necessary to recall and condemn the situation in Ecuador, which Yankee imperialism seeks to establish as a kind of forward outpost and blueprint for its intervention in the region, by incorporating the Zionist entity of Israel into its military plans and into the subjugation of the region. The despicable bombardments against peasants and poor miners on the northern border are an indication that imperialism has escalated to a more overt level of aggression; here, Ecuador-with the full collaboration of its puppet government-is a critical target.

Furthermore, the AIL declares the necessity of raising a powerful wave of social agitation against Yankee imperialism's intervention in Venezuela and Latin America, combining this struggle with the concrete fight of anti-imperialists

forces in order to raise anti-imperialist consciousness. It is necessary to turn Latin America, in particular, into a region hostile in every sense to the imperialist aggressors, and to be ready for self-defense. In this regard, all anti-imperialists on this subcontinent and in other parts of the world must be included in the process.

We must raise the slogan : Yankees, Get Out of Venezuela and Latin America!
